Directions on how to most efficiently apply the Armoni Naturali Spa shampoos and conditioners (the Italian Method):

How to use the Italian Clay Shampoos (G435, G436, G437, G421, G413, G416, G420, G414):

- Dilute the shampoo into warm water:
Example: For a very dirty Labrador Retriever: dilute 100 ml of shampoo into 3 liters of water. For a normal dirty Labrador: dilute 50 ml of shampoo into 3 liters of water.
- Without wetting the dog first, apply the shampoo/water mixture directly to the dry coat, using a sponge. Brush the dog (you may use a slicker brush, a kong brush or a massage glove) in order to make the shampoo penetrate down to the roots.
- Rinse the dog thoroughly. A second wash is not necessary, as the clay treatment cleans the dog's coat thoroughly the first time.

How to use the Italian Conditioning Balsam (G438, G424, G423):

- For damaged long coats: apply the pure conditioner and distribute it by means of a brush or a comb. Rinse.
- For long coats: dilute the Balsam with warm water into a spray bottle (1 part of Balsam into 30 parts of water), then spray the product all over the coat. Brush or comb to make the product penetrate. Rinse.

How to use the Conditioning Professional Spray conditioners (G445, G419):

Brill liquid - Dilute 1 part of the Conditioning Brill liquid into 15 parts of water and put into a spray bottle. Follow directions below.

Conditioning Spray or Brill (Pre-diluted): If the dog is extremely tangled, spray a little of the conditioning spray after the shampoo and the balsam conditioning treatment on the wet dog. Repeat the treatment when the dog is completely dry. It makes brushing and combing much easier, as well as protecting the coat from dust, oxydation and yellowing. The conditioner also prevents static. It creates a beautiful, healty shine, which is also a great final touch for dogs with short coats. The conditioner also makes clips last longer.
